### The Energy Act 2016

This act establishes the Oil and Gas Authority (OGA) as an independent regulator to manage the regulation of petroleum recovery. It makes provisions in relation to the function of the OGA, infrastructure and information, fees relating to Oil and Gas and Wind Power.
