Alongside the existing funding available from WRAP (AWM200), a new capital grant programme is being launched which aims to tackle the challenges of waste generated by companies in the West Midlands. Support of up to 45% is available for projects covering the 2 following material streams:

- Food waste via Anaerobic Digestion (AD) or In-vessel Composting (IVC).
- Commercial and Industrial Plastics
